Directions to Hilton Fort Wayne

From the North

(Michigan, Northern Ohio, or 80/90 toll road)

Go south on I-69 to exit 312A (Coldwater Road South exit) Continue South, Coldwater Road eventually merges with South Clinton Street and becomes a 1-way going south. Continue on South Clinton to the downtown area (approximately. 5 minutes) to Washington Blvd. (1-way going west). Turn right on Washington Blvd. and get in the left lane, heading west for 1 block to South Calhoun Street. Turn left on South Calhoun Street, the Hilton is on the right and the general public parking garage is on the left.

West or Northwest (from Illinois or South Bend, IN area on US 30 or US 33)

East US 30 and South US 33 merge together for a short time just west of I-69. At this point follow signs for 930 (Coliseum Blvd.) **Do not exit onto I-69**. Follow 930/Coliseum Blvd. to Lima Road (Evans Toyota will be on the right). Turn right on Lima Road. Lima Road merges with Clinton Street and becomes a 1-way going south. Continue on South Clinton to the downtown area (approximately. 5 minutes) to Washington Blvd. (1-way going west). Turn right on Washington Blvd. and get in the left lane, heading west for 1 block to South Calhoun Street. Turn left on South Calhoun Street, the Hilton is on the right and the general public parking garage is on the left.

East or Northeast (from Northern Ohio on US 24 or US 30)

Do not follow signs that put you on the I-469 bypass Continue West through New Haven to Downtown Fort Wayne. The road changes names several times, it will eventually become Washington Blvd. Washington is a 1-way street going west. Turn left on South Calhoun Street, the Hilton is on the right and the general public parking garage is on the left.

South or Southeast (from Southeast Indiana or Southwest Ohio on US 33 or US 27)

Continue north on US 27. **Do not follow signs for US 33 that direct you to I-469 by-pass**. US 27 follows Lafayette Street and becomes a 1-way. Continue north on Lafayette Street to the downtown area to Washington Blvd. (1-way). Turn left on Washington Blvd. and get in the left lane, heading west for 3 blocks to South Calhoun Street. Turn left on South Calhoun Street, the Hilton is on the right and the general public parking garage is on the left.
